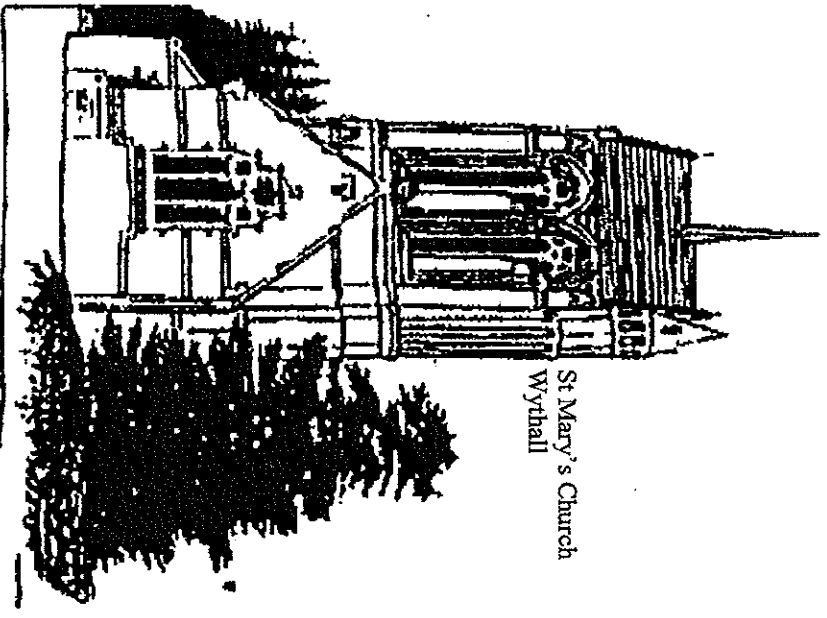


# WYTHALL

## CIRCULAR COUNTRYSIDE WALK : No.3

Wythall Park via Tanners Green and returning via Grimes Hill

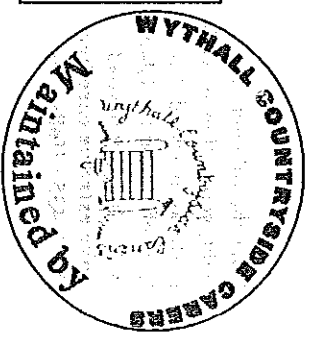
Route : 4 3/4 miles

### No. 3 In a Series of Five Walks

The route described is for guidance only.  
It reads in a clockwise direction. Being a circular route it can be started at any point to suit your requirements.  
Remember the County Code when crossing fields and the usual road safety practices when crossing any public roads, Especially when crossing the A435 / Hollywood By-pass.



**Starting at the car park in Wythall Park, Silver Street.**

From the car park, walk to the right of the large green shed and follow the park path. Take the left turn and follow the path to Bateman's Lane.

Turn left in Bateman's Lane and walk to the junction with Silver Street. Turn right into Silver Street. Pass under the bridge and look for the footpath on the left.

You may have to walk a little way past the bridge in order to get up the bank and then return along the old road.

The path follows the hedge line along the bypass for the first field then bears away to the right and eventually reaches a stile in the far corner.

From this stile follow the path round to the left and continue on, with the stable area on your left, to reach Wilmore Lane.

Turn right for a few yards to join a path on the left by the entrance to Wythwood Farm.

Follow this path under the Chestnut Trees. And on across the fields with the hedge on your left.

At the end of the second field, the path bears left, over a ditch and crosses the corner of the next field to a stile.

Over the stile with the hedge now on your right, you will meet Middle Lane - close to Becketts Island. Cross Middle Lane, turn left and to the Island, cross the main A 435 to Station Road.

**Take extreme care here when crossing the A 435 / Hollywood Bypass.**

In Station Road, take the footpath to the right hand side, opposite the School playing fields.

Pass through a small wood and at the stile, bear right on a track and on into Tanners Green Lane.

Turn left along the lane for about 200 yards and take the bridle way on the right leading to Barkers Lane.

Turn left in Barkers Lane and continue to Fulford Heath Golf Club.

The route then leads to the left of the club buildings along a short road to a kissing gate on the right by the last house.

Pass through the gate and follow the path to the right, keeping the club buildings on your right-hand side until you meet the main track.

Turn left along the track past the groundsman's buildings and follow the waymarkings across the golf course to a gate on the far side.

Go through the gate and turn left up the tree lined path.

On reaching Station Road, turn right and follow the road for about 700 yards.

Look out for Littleshaw Lane and turn left into it, following it right to the end and onto a footpath which leads between the houses and across Three Oaks Road, again between the Houses and onto the footpath.

Continue on straight ahead until you reach Houndsfield Lane and turn left.

A path leads off Simms Lane at its junction with The Reddings and brings you out to the Alcester Road by Drakes Cross Shopping Parade.

Cross over the Alcester Road and turn right along the pavement. Look out for a sign-posted path by the side of the last house.

Follow this path the end and turn left through a gate into Wythall Park.

Cross the Park or follow the Perimeter path back to the car park and your starting point.
