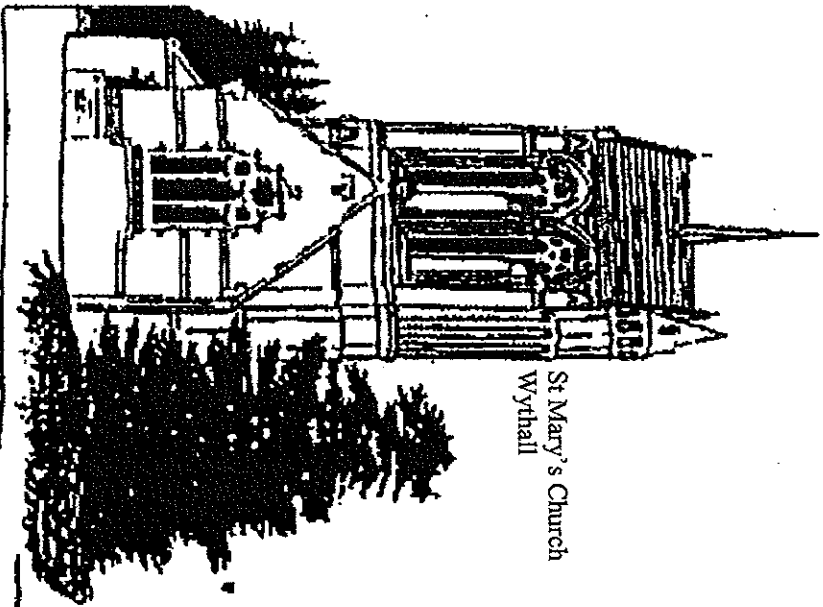

CIRCULAR COUNTRYSIDE WALK : No.4

Wythall Park along the North Worcestershire Path,
returning via Peterbrook Road

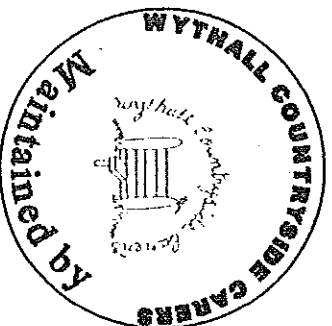
Route : 6 Miles

No. 4 In a Series of Five Walks

The route described is for guidance only.
It reads in a clockwise direction. Being a circular route it can
be started at any point to suit your requirements.
Remember the Country Code when crossing fields and the
usual road safety practices when crossing any public roads,
Especially when crossing the A435 / Hollywood By-pass



Starting in the car park, Wythall Park, Silver Street

GR SP 0775 7620

From the entrance to Wythall Park, cross over Silver Street and head down Wilmore Lane opposite.

Follow the Lane round as it bends to the left, Wilmore continues right over the By-pass road bridge, but we continue forward down Brick Kiln Lane to the junction with the Alcester Road.

Cross over here and walk a few yards to the left, along the pavement, to a stile and path across the fields.

Follow through four stiles and gates to the left hand side of a large stable shed. Cross from the corner of this field to the opposite corner and Houndsfield Lane.

Turn right along Houndsfield Lane and continue across the cross roads with Hollywood Lane.

Houndsfield Lane continues on the other side, but when you reach the last house, take the footpath on the left.

Keep to the left of the field and then at the next stile, the path turns right to join a Private Lane/Public Footpath.

Turn left along this lane which leads up to Trueman's Heath Lane.

Cross to the Pavement and turn right. Walk down to the gated entrance to Trueman's Heath Riding School.

Through the gates, take the stile to the right of the drive and follow the way marked path round the side of the stables and then rejoin the main track.

The route now continues along public roads for a short while.

Carry straight on along Trueman Heath Lane, cross Hollywood Lane and continue along Shawhurst Lane to its junction with May Lane. Turn right into May Lane and walk its length to the Alcester Road and cross over, by The Packhorse pub, into Packhorse Lane.

Just past the pub and a couple of cottages, on the left, look for the footpath on the left, immediately at the rear of the last cottage.

Follow the path down and across a small bridge over a stream, then up to a metal kissing gate in the left corner of the field.

Pass through the gate and turn right and continue forward to another metal gate.

Pass through the gate and back into Wythall Park.

Cross the Park or follow the perimeter path to the right and back round to the car park and your start point.

We hope you enjoyed this slightly longer walk, using mainly country footpaths together with some public highways.
