REGISTRAR'S REPORT – 2017/2018

The Cemetery was first used in 1965 and was set up initially for the benefit of local residents. Since then we have sold 700 burial lots (some used some reserved) and 273 cremation plots (ashes).

The past twelve months has been a very quiet period for bookings – the trend seems to be crematorium and scatter ashes thereafter.

Two new rows of burial plots have been installed in the past twelve months, use of which will commence shortly.
