

# PUBLIC NOTICE

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14 (AS AMENDED)**

**WORCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**

**NOTICE OF A TEMPORARY 10 MPH SPEED LIMIT ON C2180 ALCESTER ROAD,  
WYTHALL, ("THE HIGHWAY")**

Reason for restriction: Cats Eyes Installation and Resurfacing Works.

Restriction: a 10 mph speed limit.

1. The effect of this Notice is that no vehicle shall proceed along that part of C2180 Alcester Road at a speed exceeding 10 mph from its junction with A435 Hollywood Bypass to its junction with U23458 Shawhurst Lane.
2. No speed limit imposed by this Notice applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation 3(5) of those regulations.
3. This provision shall continue in force for a maximum of 5 days. However it is anticipated that it will remain force for 2 days commencing on 17 July 2019.

Nothing in this Notice shall prevent at any time access for pedestrians to any premises situated on or adjacent to the highway, or to any other premises accessible for pedestrians from and only from the highway.
